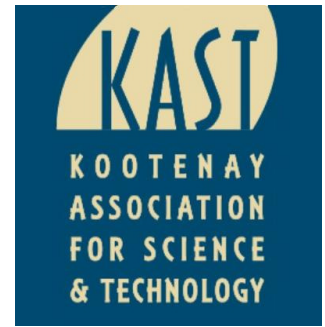

Rules/Guidelines

- Films must be maximum 10 minutes in length. No minimum length. SHORTER IS BETTER
- DVD format, best quality possible for the big screen (Royal Theatre in Trail – BIG SCREEN)
- Please keep adult assistance to a minimum. Films that have lots of obvious adult assistance will not be considered for the festival.
- Films are not guaranteed to be screened. Our panel of qualified judges will preview all films and will choose the best and most appropriate film submissions that take up the two 3-hour sections of U19 festival. Inappropriate films will not be screened.
- Participants are free to enter as many categories as they would like and there is no cost to submit films.
- Past entries have included: ski and snowboard movies, mockumentaries, music videos, horror flicks, documentaries, dramas, public service announcements, comedies, you name it.

Find a category that your film could fit in, have fun and be creative!

PRIZES:

- ~ **Animation** - Winners get the CBT \$200 Cash prize
- ~ **Documentary** - Winners get the KAST \$200 Cash prize
- ~ **Drama** - Winners get the CBT \$200 Cash prize
- ~ **Sports/Adventure** - Winners get the KSCU \$200 Cash prize
- ~ **Original Music** – Winners get the Columbia Power \$200 Cash prize
